

Azalea Care Instructions

Scientific Name:

Rhododendron or Indicum Hybrids
row-doe-DEN-dron-IN-di-kum

Water:

Moderately moist soil is preferred. Water thoroughly when just the soil is dry to the touch. Do not allow plants to dry out or stand in water.

Light: Indirect or bright-diffused light is best.

Temperature:

Santa Maria's delightful climate is ideal for the lovely azalea. Cool 65F to 70F degrees during the daytime and 55F-60F degree at night.

Tips:

Azaleas are available in many flower forms and colors including white, pink, salmon, red, purple and variegated.

After enjoying indoors plant in part sunlight.

Azaleas need acid soil or their leaves may yellow.

Scale and whiteflies can be a problem.
